26	belief, an adequate remedy is available to the Government by expedited hearing rather th	
27	delaying further the appeal of the denial of protest and seeking a determination	of
28	substantial interest;

- Upon information and belief, the Government was awarded the federal grant on (ii)September 30, 2018, and failed to diligently and timely issue a request for procurement to account for protest timelines permitted under Guam law. Granting the Government confirmation of a determination of substantial interest encourages the lack of diligent and timely procurement, and undermines the protections granted under Guam law to appellant;
- (iii) Upon information and belief, the Government has failed to substantiate its claim of loss of current federal grants and loss of future grants, under penalty of perjury of the laws of Guam.
- Upon information and belief the Government has failed to substantiate that the federal (iv) grants awarded are not permitted any extensions of time, under penalty of perjury of the laws of Guam.
- The notice provided on August 23, 2019 to counsel of record is deficient. All notices (v) required under Guam law require actual notice, and the notice is deficient for failure to properly notify appellant of the applicability of Guam law. No such right of determination of substantial interest is available to the Government under 5 GCA § 5249(g)(2) exists under Guam law.
