In its Decision of April 21, 2011, the Office of Public Accountability required the General Services Agency and the Department of Public Health and Social Services to provide as follows:

"5. GSA and DPHSS should conduct an independent analysis of what specific laws, codes and regulations apply to the Radiology Imaging System equipment and its installation to determine whether the equipment and its installation GSA and DPHSS received pursuant to



Purchase Order No. P106A06027 complied with Federal Regulations, Title 10, Title 49, and all

changes and amendments thereto, NRC Regulatory Compliance Tests, ALARA, NCRP,

MOSA, and other guidelines and applicable Guam Regulations, Ordinances and Codes

A.S.M.E., NEC, HFPA Standards, Life Safety Code, and Uniform Building Codes, as required

by said purchase order. Such independent analysis is necessary because the IFB's and the

Purchase Order's mere citation of a broad spectrum of laws, regulations, and codes, are not

sufficient to protect the health and safety of the DPHSS staff and patients who will use the

Radiology Imaging System."

The General Services Agency and the Department of Public Health and Social Services

are making good faith efforts to comply with this requirement of the Invitation For Bid and the

Decision in this matter. Arrangements have been made for a physicist contracted with the

Guam Memorial Hospital Authority to inspect the installation of the radiology imaging system

that has been installed by Medpharm pursuant to this acquisition. This inspection is expected

to take place in the very near future. See Exhibit A and B, attached.

In furtherance of assuring that all required steps are taken in this regard, the Office of

the Attorney General has written to the Director of the Department of Public Health and Social

Services, advising him of the requirements of the Invitation For Bid, and seeking his

compliance with the Decision in this matter. See Exhibit C, attached.

Dear Mr. Gillan,

I am an Assistant Attorney General contacting you on behalf of this office, and on behalf of the General Services Agency. I take this opportunity to apprise you of the status of the acquisition of a radiology imaging system, and an appeal of this acquisition, both referenced above. It is my understanding that the radiology imaging system has been installed at the Department of Public Health and Social Services in Mangilao by Medpharm on or about June, 2011. The status of its completion and certification for operation are not clear. The appeal filed in the acquisition by JMI-Edison has been denied, and the contract to Medpharm upheld.

The decision of the Public Auditor stated that the Department of Public Health and Social Services and the General Services Agency had responsibilities going forward to assure that the radiology imaging system installed by Medpharm met the requirements of the Invitation For Bid ("IFB"). The decision states:

"5. spectrum of laws, regulations, and codes, are not sufficient to protect the health and safety of the DPHSS staff and patients who will use the Radiology Imaging System."

I wish to emphasize that we have received much cooperation from your department and your staff. This is not an attempt to suggest that the department has failed to meet its obligations. Having said that. I nonetheless need to advise you that the Office of Public Accountability has on more than one occasion contacted the General Services Agency seeking clarification that paragraph #5 quoted above is being complied with at this time. The General Services Agency is expected to respond appropriately to the Office of Public Accountability in the very near future. For this reason, and to assure that you are cognizant of this obligation, I bring this directly to your attention.

It is my understanding that arrangements are being made to have a physicist engaged by Guam Memorial Hospital inspect the radiology imaging system installed by Medpharm pursuant to this IFB. I would request that you assure that all necessary certifications are provided as required by the IFB and by the decision of the Public Auditor as expediently as possible.

Please do not hesitate to contact me if there is anything my office can do to assist you in meeting these responsibilities. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
