Notice of Award and Bid Status was only provided to me on Sept. 2, 2021. I had been following up since June, July and August many times but the answer was that they are still enaluating the bid.

The Administrator reasoned out that it was an oversight on her part. (Plesse see her letter dated Sept. 2 (Exhibit A) My concern or the violation is the Notice of A ward was provided first on June 7, 2021 but the Bid Status which was not sent to me was dated July 1. (Please see Exhibit B and C) The spees of Docomos of fer does not comply with the intention and Background as provided in Exhibit A of the Bid (pages 20). The offer was specifically for homes not classrooms.

The offer that was favored was made in Israel not USA. UOG should be buying American made for Federal funding projects to comply with Buy American Act.

UDG violates the provisions in Instruction 12, Method of Amard because the product they approved does not conform for class rooms use but only for homes. It is not in the public interest that UDG will buy of award the bid that does not served its purpose. Yes the product is cheep and the lowest bid but just a waste of money since it is not designed for schools. Plasse see page 5 of Bid Document (Method of Amard.

Reling Requested

It is up to OPA to determine the appropriate rulingor sanction to correct this wrong disposition on Method of Amard and not following the basic Guam Procurement Law on Bid Status and Notice of Amard. I also have to add that they (UOG) are the only one charging \$25.00 for Bid Documents in PDF file. All agencies does not charge \$25.00 if Bidders download the file.
