

**THIS MATTER** came before the Hearing Officer on July 9, 2010 pursuant to Appellant's Motion to reschedule the time of the Hearing Re Appellant's Statement of Costs and Reasonable Profit and Motion for Attorney's Fees as Costs and Purchasing Agency Department of Education's (DOE) Motion to Extend the time to file an Opposition to Appellant's Statement of Costs and Reasonable Profit and Motion for Attorney's Fees as Costs. Appellant argues that

1 the July 19, 2010 hearing should be rescheduled due "their client" being off-island. The Hearing  
2 Officer finds that Appellant's motion has no merit because the Appellant is a Corporation and a  
3 corporate representative should be available to testify on behalf of the Appellant if desired by the  
4 Appellant. Further, the Hearing Officer finds that Purchasing Agency DOE's Motion to Extend  
5 Time has no merit and is moot because Purchasing Agency DOE filed their opposition to the  
6 Appellant's Statement of Costs and Reasonable Profit and Motion for Attorney's Fees as Costs  
7 on July 6, 2010.

8 Based on the foregoing, Appellant's Motion to reschedule the time of the Hearing Re  
9 Appellant's Statement of Costs and Reasonable Profit and Motion for Attorney's Fees as Costs  
10 and Purchasing Agency DOE's Motion to Extend the time to file an Opposition to Appellant's  
11 Statement of Costs and Reasonable Profit and Motion for Attorney's Fees as Costs are hereby  
12 DENIED.
