Hafa Adai! On behalf of Data Management Resources, LLC (DMR), I hereby submit this formal protest of the Notice of Rejection, dated February 28, 2012, and received on February 29, 2012. This protest is made pursuant to Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, \$5425(a), and within fourteen (14) days of notice of the events giving rise to this protest.

"GSA/DOA" herein shall mean the General Services Agency, Department of Administration, Government of Guam.

RFP/DOA-014-11 Point-of-Sale (POS) shall hereafter be referred to as "RFP-POS."

DMR protests the Notice of Rejection on the following grounds:

(1) Rejection is not warranted under 2 GARR \$3114(I). GSA/DOA has failed to determine that the Best and Final Offer submitted by DMR was not fair and reasonable, as required by law.

(2) GSA/DOA failed to act in good faith in the negotiations with DMR, as required by 5 GCA §5003 and 2 GAR §1105.

A rejection in this procurement violates procurement regulations. Specifically, 2 GAR §3114(I) provides, in part "The head of the agency conducting the procurement or a designee of such officer shall negotiate a contract with the best qualified offeror for the required services at compensation determined in writing to be fair and reasonable. (emphasis added). It further provides, in part, that GSA/DOA is required to conduct itself in the negotiation towards "agreeing upon compensation which is fair and reasonable, taking into account the estimated value of the required services, and the scope, complexity and nature of such services.

EXHIBIT 2 NOTICE OF APPEAL RFP/DOA-014-11 GSA/DOA in evaluating the Best and Final Offer submitted by DMR failed to make a determination that the offer provided by DMR was not fair and reasonable compensation for the services requested.

GSA/DOA's rejection of DMR's final offer in the amount of \$1,823,100.00 based on a claim of "insufficient funds for such project" was made in bad faith. Where the parties have entered into contract negotiations, lack of funds is not a sufficient basis to reject a Best and Final Offer under Guam procurement law. Rejection of an offer under RFP-POS is governed by 2 GAR \$3114(l). Because GSA/DOA failed to comply with the requirements of law, the rejection must be vacated and DMR's protest sustained.

As set forth above, GSA/DOA has failed to act in good faith in the administration of this procurement. Please see enclosed the September 28, 2011 First Counter Offer submitted by GSA/DOA offering a Total of \$2,295,582.69 for RFP-POS. In contrast, DMR's Best and Final Offer was below the initial First Counter Offer of GSA/DOA. Thus, GSA/DOA's claim that there is no funding despite its previous offer is clearly a bad faith attempt to terminate negotiation and reject DMR's Best and Final Offer.

Additionally, GSA/DOA acted in bad faith in the negotiation of the contract for RFP-POS; specifically, GSA/DOA, by and through its employees and in collusion with other Government of Guam employees, met with and entered into discussion on a Point-of-Sale integration plan with a third party, during the pendency of the negotiation of RFP-POS.

On behalf of DMR, I respectfully submit this PROTEST, and request that you keep me informed of the status.

Please be advised that the Department of Administration, Bureau of Information Technology, Department of Revenue and Taxation, Treasurer of Guam and the General Services Agency were served with Requests for Disclosure of Public Documents under the Sunshine Reform Act of 1999, as Amended. Pending the disclosure of public documents, DMR reserves its right to amend this Protest within a reasonable time of the disclosure, as permitted under Guam law.

Buenas Yan Hafa Adai! This is to acknowledge receipt of your protest letter dated 13 March 2012, in which you protested the government's rejection for Request for Proposal No.: RFP/DOA-014-11. The appropriate section for rejection of this proposal is 2 GARR Division 4, Section 3115(e)(3)(B) which states in pertinent part:

(e) Rejection of Individual Bids or Proposals

(b)As used in this Subsection, proposal means any offer submitted in response to any solicitation,except a bid as defined in Subsection 3115 (e)(3)(a) of this Section. Unless the solicitation states otherwise, proposals need not be unconditionally accepted without alteration or correction, and the territory's stated requirements may be revised or clarified after proposals are submitted. The flexibility must be considered in determining whether reasons exist for rejecting all or any part of a proposal. Reasons for rejecting proposals include but are not limited to:

(iii) the proposed price is clearly unreasonable.

The proposed price is clearly unreasonable to what the government had believed such service to be worth. Since the government did not have the funds available, rejection is authorized by the procurement regulations.

Therefore, your protest on this issue is deemed to be without merit and is denied. Please be advised that upon receipt of this letter this is the final decision of the Chief

Procurement Officer. You have the right to seek administrative or judicial review as authorized by law.

As to the other issues raised, the General Services Agency is unaware of any facts to form a response to your protest.
