GDOE IFB 008-2013, Indefinite Quantity Purchase of Air Conditioning Equipment

This submission is offered to supplement Appendix A: Notice of Appeal Form, Part IV.

I. STATEMENT OF GROUNDS FOR APPEAL

A. RELEVANT BACKGROUND

JMI-Edison ("JMI") was an offeror which submitted a bid pursuant to an Invitation for Bid ("IFB") issued by the Guam Department of Education ("GDOE") and opened publicly on March 28, 2013. The IFB pertained to GDOE IFB 008-2013, and sought proposals to provide GDOE an Indefinite Quantity Purchase of Air Conditioning Equipment. A "Bid Status and Intent to Award" was received by JMI on June 22, 2013 regarding GDOE IFB 008-2013 indicating that another offeror has been awarded the contract. *See* Bid Status and Intent to Award, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. On July 3, 2013 JMI submitted a Procurement Protest to GDOE citing several errors in GDOE's evaluation of JMI's offer. On July 25, 2013 GDOE issued its decision denying JMI's protest. *See* Decision, attached hereto as **Exhibit B**. For the

reasons set forth below, GDOE erred in its determination that JMI submitted a non-responsive bid. This Appeal to the Office of Public Accountability is submitted within 15 days of the issuance GDOE's denial of the JMI's protest and is timely submitted pursuant to 5 GCA §5425.

This appeal continues the statutory stay that was triggered by JMI's protest of July 3, 2013.

JMI has been advised that there were four offerors who responded to the IFB, and that offeror J&B Modern Tech (J&B) was awarded the contract at issue here. The Bid Status and Intent to Award explained that JMI was determined to be "non-responsive" due to a purported failure to comport with Clarification 1, which contained the instruction that "Bidders shall offer one (1) price per item and shall submit (1) bid." GDOE's finding of non-compliance was erroneous; JMI did not violate the instructions given in Clarification 1 and its bid should not have been deemed non-responsive.

JMI protested the award and brings this appeal on the grounds that it did not submit an unresponsive bid, and that the contracting officer erroneously determined that its detailed submission was instead an impermissible alternate bid. JMI's bid not violate the terms of the IFB, was in full compliance with Clarification 1, and was ultimately the lowest priced bid. As the lowest priced responsive bidder, JMI should be awarded the GDOE IFB 008-2013 Contract. The specific nature of JMI's protest is discussed more fully below.

B. GROUND FOR APPEAL: JMI'S SUBMISSION WAS RESPONSIVE

The IFB asked offerors to submit pricing for the purchase and installation of new air conditioning units ("AC Units"). The IFB did not provide detailed specifications. For example, the IFB did not contain specifications such as voltage and phase type. Clarification 1 was issued by GDOE to provide some guidance, but contained the specific instruction that "Bidders shall

offer one (1) price per item and shall submit one (1) bid...." See Clarification 1, attached hereto as **Exhibit C**. Offerors were also provided with Amendment 3 to the IFB which required the offerors to perform a site visit to the two schools, where all of the offerors were shown the locations where the A/C Units would be installed. See Amendment 3, attached hereto as **Exhibit D**. During the school inspection, DOE informed the offerors that some of the units would be replaced, others would be completely new installations. JMI was also able to determine the phase type and voltage needed for the installations.

To be completely accurate, JMI's detailed bid included the following information:

- a) Specific Prices for the air conditioning units based on actual specifications (voltage and phase). See Bid Items 6, 7, 8, 10, and 12.
- b) Specific Prices based on actual scope of work (replacement or new installation). *See* Bid Items 5, and 7.

Nothing that was submitted by JMI ran afoul of the IFB, its clarifications, or amendments. To the contrary, JMI's submission was specifically crafted to provide the clarity necessitated by the mandatory site visit. Despite this, GDOE relied upon Clarification 1's instruction to submit "one bid" as a basis for determining that JMI's submission was non-responsive.

Clarification 1 (F) explained that:

Bidders shall offer one (1) price per item and shall submit one (1) bid. Section 2.2.6 on page 8 titled, "ALTERNATE BIDS NOT ACCEPTED", states an alternate bid will not be accepted. If a bidder submits two bids, GDOE may determine both bids as alternate bids and deem both bids non-responsive.

The issue is whether JMI submitted an Alternate Bid. As discussed above, JMI's detailed bid was not an alternate bid. Rather, it was a detailed bid identifying units that would be replaced or newly installed. In this instance, GDOE simply misunderstood JMI's bid.

GDOE's conclusion that JMI's bid was an Alternate Bid was in error because this was an IDIQ solicitation, and offerors were not provided with the quantity or specifications of the A/C Units to be supplied. This uncertainty is best addressed by an offeror providing the type of details such as quantity, type, model and whether the units were to be a new install or replacement of an existing unit.

With respect to Bid Item 5, JMI indicated that 349 A/C Units would be supplied. JMI provided a breakdown showing that of the 349 A/C Units, 340 were replacement units and 9 units were new installations. *See* Bid Specifications Submitted by JMI, pg. 27; 41, attached hereto as **Exhibit E**. **One lump sum price for the 349 A/C Units was given in JMI's bid for the sum of \$9,055,474.** *Id*. The breakdown of units was not an Alternate Bid, it was simply a breakdown. There is no other way to interpret the breakdown.

II. RULING REQUESTED

Section 2.4.1(b) of the IFB states that the bid award will be based upon the "Total Lump Sum Bid Price." JMI's total lump sum bid price was \$9,055,474. The awardee, J&B's total was nearly two million dollars higher, at \$10,926,274. JMI was the lowest priced responsive offeror and should be awarded the GDO IFB 008-2013 contract.

The Total Lump Sum Bid Price for the 1st Year Contract Price will be determined by adding all the prices contained in Bid Form Item (D).

Dear Attorney Walsh,

This letter is written in response to your letter of protest dated July 3, 2013 regarding Guam Department of Education ("GDOE") Invitation for Bid No. 008-2013 GDOE Invitation for Bid 008-2013 for Indefinite Quantity for Purchase of AC Equipment ("IFB"). GDOE has reviewed your protests and hereby denies them in their entirety on the following bases:

I. JMI's Bid was Nonresponsive

On June 22, 2013, GDOE disqualified your client JMI-Edison ("JMI") based on the determination that JMI's bid was nonresponsive to the IFB. GDOE came to its conclusion to disqualify JMI after review the requirements of the GDOE IFB 008-2013's amendments and clarifications. Pursuant to 5 GCA §5201(g), responsiveness of a bidder will be determined by compliance with the requirements of the IFB.

Section 2.4.1 of the IFB states that an evaluation factor for award is that a bidder must be responsive to the requirements of this IFB. The IFB required that all bids must be submitted in the format of the Bid Form included with the IFB. GDOE disclosed to all bidders that one price per item must be submitted. The IFB's Clarification No. 1 states that "[b]idders shall offer one (1) price per item and shall submit one (1) bid."

JMI submitted a bid in response to the IFB. The bid contained a bid form that included multiple prices for a number of air conditioner unit types. See Attachment A. GDOE made the determination that JMI was nonresponsive to the requirements of the IFB when it included more than one price per item as required by the IFB as required by the IFB's Clarification No. 1. A mandatory site visit resulted in additional information on voltage and phase specifications and replacement versus new installation of air conditioner units. However, the new information did not change the "one (1) price per item" requirement of the IFB's Clarification No. 1. Therefore, GDOE denies your protest.

II. J&B's Bid was Responsive

You assert that the OPA Consolidated Decision in OPA-PA-13-002 and OPA-PA-13-003 held that J&B Modern Tech ("J&B") held a debarred status at the time of its bid was opened, and thus, J&B's bid should not have been reviewed or considered. This is an erroneous reading of the OPA's decision. In fact, the OPA vacated the suspension of J&B and explicitly stated that GDOE was to consider J&B's bid for the IFB. See Attachment B. Therefore, GDOE denies your protest.

Therefore, GDOE denies your protest in its entirety. Please be advised that your have the right to appeal this denial pursuant to 5 G.C.A. § 5425(e).

Gentlemen:

Please refer to our Invitation for Bid No. <u>GDOE IFB 008-2013, INDEFINITE QUANTITY BID FOR PURCHASE OF AIR CONDITIONING EQUIPMENT</u> a copy of which was issued to your company for consideration.

Please make necessary change (s) specified below:

Questions submitted by J & B Modern Tech, January 30, 2013 at 5:16 p.m., via E-Mail:

A. As to the fourth paragraph in item 17, beginning on page 4 of IFB No. 008-2013, J&B notes its concern that it is unusual and impractical for a contractor to warrant mechanical equipment maintained (or not maintained, or improperly maintained) by someone else. Therefore, J&B respectfully request that DOE reconsider this provision. However, in the event that DOE does not choose to do so, J&B has the following question. How is the Contractor to verify that preventive maintenance is being performed on the installed HVAC units in accordance with the preventive maintenance schedule, and that the units are not being neglected, sabotaged or otherwise damaged, if someone other than the Contractor is performing such maintenance?

Response: The successful contractor MUST provide the five year warranty as specified in the IFB. The GDOE will not consider any changes to this stipulation. To answer the second part of the question, a Preventive Maintenance Contract is part of this IFB. All units will be placed on a P.M. schedule. An existing S.O.P. is in place to ensure that all units have been properly cleaned. GDOE hires Contractors who are reputable, responsible and respectful. We expect Contractors to operate to the highest standards of professionalism.

B. Also as to the fourth paragraph in item 17, how will it be determined whether a needed repair is due to fallure of the unit to meet warranted requirements, rather than unperformed maintenance or improperly performed maintenance if someone other than the Contractor is performing such maintenance?

Response: Refer to Response to letter A.

C. As to item 18.B. on page 5, J&B notes its concern that it and other contractors may not have staff working on weekends and holidays, therefore, J&B respectfully request that DOE reconsider this provision. However, in the event that DOE does not choose to do so, J&B has the following question. Does this provision mean that although repair and replacement parts need usually only be available within five days, they must be available the same day on Saturdays, Sundays and Government of Guam holidays? Or does

this mean that Saturdays, Sundays and Government of Guam holidays will be counted in the five days, so that "five days" means calendar days rather than business days.

Response: As to 18.B, the IFB is specific. The contractor is required to have replacement parts available within five calendar days that includes weekends and holidays. No exceptions to this requirement.

D. As to item 19 on page 5, J&B notes that the parenthetical exception in this item means that 12,000 BTU units are not required to have Fresh Air Intakes. What is controlling, item 19 on page 5 or page 23?

Response: On page 23 of the IFB, there is no mention that requires the unit to have Fresh Air Intakes/Make-up –Air Units be installed. Item #19 on page 5 stands.

E. As to item 2.2.5 on page 7, requiring bid submission in the format of the Bid Form included in the IFB, can a bid be submitted on a "Xerox" or similarly copied form, rather than the actual Bid Form included in the IFB, so long as all information and signatures provided by the bidder are original?

Response: No. Bids must be submitted in the format of the Bid Form included with this IFB. Bids submitted in any other format will be deemed nonresponsive and disqualified from participation in this solicitation. Bidders may enter either by handwritten or type information onto the actual bid form but will not alter the bid form any way.

F. As to item 2.2.6 on page 8, are bidders allowed to offer an option of another brand of air conditioner, as has been the case in prior bidding for air conditioners?

Response: Bidders shall offer one (1) price per item and shall submit one (1) bid. Section 2.2.6 on page 8 titled, "ALTERNATE BIDS NOT ACCEPTED", states an alternate bid will not be accepted. If a bidder submits two bids, GDOE may determine both bids as alternate bids and deem both bids non-responsive.

G. As to item 2.4.3 on page 10, why is this information not required with the original bid submission?

Response: GDOE has determined this information is not required with bid submission, however, the GDOE reserves the right to request such information, therefore, bidders should be prepared to promptly provide to GDOE information relating to the bidder's responsibility. Failure of a bidder to comply with a request by GDOE for information relating to responsibility may result in a determination that a bidder is not responsible and therefore disqualified from an award.

H. As to item 2.5.3 on page 11, may invoices be submitted once the units are received by the Contractor from its Vendor?

Response: No, invoices may only be submitted once the unit has been installed and Q.Cd. (Quality Controlled) and signed off by the Manager of the Division of Facilities and Maintenance of the GDOE.

I. As to page 28: (i) how many 208/230 volts units, and how many 460 volts units?; and (ii) how many 1 phase units, and how many 3 phase units?

Response: Thirty (30) each 3 phase, 460 volts and One (1) each single phase 208/230 volts.

J. Also on page 28, should this be "SEER" rather than "EER"? J&B believes the factory uses SEER for all units of 5 tons and below.

Response: Units are given a SEER rating for units under 5 ton and units 5 ton and above are given EER ratings.

K. As to page 29: (i) how many 208/230 volts units, and how many 460 volts units?; and (ii) how many 1 phase units, and how many 3 phase units?

Response: Eighteen (18) each 3 phase, 208/230 and Two Hundred Eighteen (218) each single phase, 208/230.

L. Also as to page 29, should this be "SEER" rather than "EER"? J&B believes the factory uses SEER for all units of 5 tons and below.

Response: Units 5 ton and above are EER rated.

M. As to page 30: (i) how many 208/230 volts units, and how many 460 volts units?; and (ii) how many 1 phase units, and how many 3 phase units?

Response: Eight (8) each 3 phase 460 volts, and One (1) each 3 phase 208/230 volts.

N. As to page 31: (i) how many 208/230 volts units, and how many 460 volts units?; and (ii) how many 1 phase units, and how many 3 phase units?

Response: Two (2) each 3 phase, 460 volts.

O. As to page 32: (i) how many 208/230 volts units, and how many 460 volts units?; and (ii) how many 1 phase units, and how many 3 phase units?

Response: Eight (8) each 3 phase 460 volts and Two (2) each 3 phase 208/230 volts.

As to page 47, item 4, J&B has the same concerns and questions noted in "A" and "B" above: (i) how is the Contractor to verify that preventive maintenance is being performed on the installed HVAC units in accordance with the preventive maintenance schedule, and that the units are not being neglected, sabotaged or otherwise damaged, if someone other than the Contractor is performing such maintenance?; and (ii) how will it be determined whether a needed repair is due to failure of the unit to meet warranted requirements, rather unperformed maintenance or improperly performed maintenance if someone other than the Contractor is performing such maintenance?

Response: Refer to question A's Response.

CLARIFICATION NO. 1 IFB 008-2013 February 05, 2013

Z. As to item 17 on pages 4-5, and the provisions relating to warranty on page 47, what is the scope of the required warranty? J&B notes that typically the warranty for all factory units installed by dealer authorized technicians is a five year warranty for the compressor and parts only.

Response: The five (5) year warranty specified on item 17 pages 4 and 5 is inclusive of parts, compressor and labor. Should a unit require repair, then the successful bidder will make the proper repairs at no cost to the GDOE.

Question: As the above mentioned bid is an "Indefinite Quantity Bid", may we therefore ask for waiver of the 15% bond requirement?

Pursuant to 5 GCA § 5212, titled, "BID SECURITY AND PERFORMANCE BOND REQUIREMENT FOR CONTRACTORS" which states in part, "Bid security shall be required for all competitive sealed bidding for the procurement of supplies or services when the total price is estimated by the Chief Procurement Officer to exceed Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00). Furthermore, §3109(c)(3) states in part, "The use of a bid bond, however, is required when a performance bond is required.

Calculation of Bid Bond: Section 2.5.4.1. states in part,"... A bid guarantee or bid bond in the amount of fifteen percent (15%) of the bidder's total bid price must be included with the bid." For the purpose of calculating the bidder's total bid price for bonding purposes (Bid Bond, Performance Bond and Payment Bond), Bidder's will use the aggregate of total lump sum bid price for the extension [the sum of Column (C)] and the total lump sum bid price for the 1st year contract price [the sum of Column (D)]. Both totals are found on page 41.




