II. Solicitation Information.

This appeal pertains to the GDOE E-Rate Network (GENET) 2016 - E-Rate Internal Connections - Wireless Local Ara Network (WLAN) Installation Services IFB No. 010-2016 (Multi-Step). Bidders are required to install (expanding) the WLAN infrastructure at the following GDOE schools: 1) George Washington High School; 2) Okkodo High School; 3) Southern High School; 4) John F. Kennedy High School; 5) Tiyan High School; 6) Agueda Johnston Middle School; 7) Astumbo Middle School; 8) F.B. Leon Guerrero Middle School; 9) Inarajan Middle School; 10) Jose Rios Middle School; 11) L.P. Untalan Middle School; 12) Oceanview Middle School; and 13) Vicente Benavente Middle School. The GDOE WLAN was designed to support the WLAN expansion to increase Wi-Fi coverage in all schools.

On March 4, 2016, GDOE issued Bid Status for GDOE IFB 010-2016 recommending an award to Docomo Pacific.

III. Concise Statement of the Grounds for Appeal.

- A. GDOE failed to objectively evaluate the bid submissions for GDOE IFB 010-2010. TFT's bid was the lowest, most responsible bid.
- **B.** GDOE improperly presumed and concluded that Docomo Pacific's acknowledgement of receipt for Addendum 2 would correct any of its bid discrepancy. Docomo's acknowledgement merely indicates a receipt of the amendments.
- **C.** GDOE improperly recommended GDOE IFB 010-2016 for award to a nonresponsive bidder, namely, Docomo Pacific.

When filing all other required documents with our office, please provide one original and two copies to OPA, and serve a copy to TFT. Although the Guam Procurement Law and Regulations require only one copy of the procurement record, OPA respectfully asks that DOE provide one original and two copies of the said record, which will be distributed as follows: Copy-1: Master File; Copy-2: Public Auditor; and Copy-3: Hearing Officer.
