



Repair/Renovation of Oceanview Middle School Gymnasium

Per your instruction the undersigned together with Franck Cepeda, Carpenter II, proceeded to Oceanview Middle School in the afternoon of July 01, 2010. We met with Ms. Cheryl Gumabong, School Administrative Officer and inquired about what Z4 Corporation has done if there was any on the proposed project, Repair/Renovation of the Gymnasium.

Ms. Gumabong disclosed that from the time after the pre-construction meeting which was conducted several months ago at F & M office here in Piti, Z4 Corporation had only one visit made to the project site. They made a tour of the site, took some measurements and the primary purpose was to reroute traffic for the students due to the proposed construction and also to prepare to secure the perimeter of the project site for safety. So far from then up to the present NOTHING has been done.

On July 02, 2010 Frank Cepeda and the undersigned went to Z4 Corp. office/stockyard. We met with Pete Valencia, the Company's President and General Manager and a certain Armando Aragon. We discussed several items on their reasonable cost claim and inquired if they could substantiate or if they have something to show proof.

Item A:- Pete Valencia and Armando Aragon alleged that the structure they have fabricated were already disposed off considering the length of time the project has been pending and the materials used were light materials (wood) and also said structure is obstructing some areas of their stockyard hence the necessity to dispose such. In addition they alleged that their claim does not include material cost as reflected. (No way for Frank Cepeda and me to substantiate this item)

Items B,C,E,F,G & I- We believe these are legitimate claims but as to the amount , we have no way of computing such.

Item D- Pete Valencia AND Armando Aragon alleged that the charges does not only reflect

the number of hours they actually spent on the pre-con meeting (pre-con meeting approx. 1½ hours) but the total holds they spent for the purpose (travel and waiting time til) the start of the actual pre-con meeting).

This report is submitted for your final decision whether to accept such claim or require Z4 Cor for some paper works (such as computation on some items) or to accept it as is in order to expectosure of this issue and in order to proceed with the re-bid of this long awaited project.

# **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

1. **Project Description:** The Contractor shall provide all labor, material, equipment and incidentals required to repair the Oceanview Middle School Gymnasium. Coordinate work schedule with Contracts Office's Construction Representative. The following work is as follows:

Scope of Work: The Work involves gymnasium repairs for Oceanview Middle School, Agat, Guam. Work includes but is not limited to demolition, earthwork, and site improvements. Work also includes roof work, metal fabrication, sheet metal, insulation, gypsum board ceilings, ceramic tile, acoustical ceilings, resilient flooring, custom cabinets and fixtures, carpentry, glass windows, painting, metal doors, wood doors, metal frames, door hardware, toilet partitions and accessories, classroom equipment, electrical, ventilation, air conditioning, and plumbing complete and ready for use.

Contractor must possess the necessary license to do all items in the Scope of Work. Items in the SOW, which may affect classes (such as painting work, etc.) shall be done after class hours from 2:00 PM to 6:00 PM on weekdays and from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays. Paint shall match existing or referred to the School Administrator for color selection and a minimum of two (2) coats. # 6. SCHEDULING REQUIREMENTS:

a. Have materials, equipment, and personnel required to perform the work at the site prior to the commencement of the work. The Contractor shall conduct his operations so as to cause the least possible interference with the normal operations of the school.

# 7. CONTRACTOR ACCESS AND USE OF SCHOOL:

- a. Working Hours: Regular working hours shall consist of a period established by the Contracts Office between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding Saturday, Sunday and Holidays.
- b. Work Outside Regular Hours: Work outside regular working hours requires Contract Manager approval. Coordinate all work outside regular working hours with the Contracts Office three days in advance to allow arrangements from the school administrator for the area to be available for construction work and for inspecting the work in progress. During periods of darkness, the different parts of the work shall be lighted in a manner approved by the Contract Manager.

# 8. EXISTING WORK:

Remove or alter existing work in such a manner as to prevent damage to any portions of the existing work, which remain. Repair or replace portions of existing work, which have been altered during construction operations to match existing or adjoining work, as approved by the Contract Manager. At the completion of operations, existing work shall be in a condition equal to or better than that which existed before new work started.

# 9. PRECONSTRUCTION CONFERENCE:

After award of the contract, but prior to commencement of any work at the site, meet with representatives of the Contracts Office to discuss and develop a mutual understanding relative to the administration of the safety program, preparation and submission of shop drawings and other submittals, scheduling, programming and prosecution of work. Contact GPSS Contracts Office to arrange a schedule for this conference.

# 10. MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT TO BE SALVAGED:

Except where specified otherwise herein, existing materials and equipment which are required to be removed or disconnected to perform the work, but are not indicated or specified for use in the new work, shall become the property of the Contractor and shall be removed from the school property.

## 11. OFFICE OF THE CONTRACTOR:

The Contractor shall maintain an office or place of business in Guam, during the term of the contract, manned and equipped with telephone and facsimile (FAX) service during regular working hours and at all times when work is in progress.

### 12. DAILY REPORT:

When work commences under this contract, the Contractor is required to submit a "Contractor Production Report" form furnished by the Contracts Office. The form shall be completed daily and delivered to the Contract Manager or his authorized representative by no later than 10:00 a.m. the following workday.

# 13. SCHEDULING REQUIREMENTS:

The Contractor shall have materials, equipment, and personnel required to perform the work at the site prior to beginning work at the site. It is essential that this requirement be strictly adhered to so as to minimize in convenience to the school.

# 14. CONTRACTOR'S INVOICE AND CONTRACT PERFORMANCE STATEMENT:

The Contract Manager will furnish forms. The Contractor has the option to use the Government furnished progress schedule and record form. Requests for payment shall be processed in accordance with the Contract Clause entitled "Payment Under Construction Contract." Invoices and supporting forms for work performed shall be submitted the Contracts Office to consist of the following:

The Contractor's invoice shall show in summary form the basis for arriving at the amount of the invoice.

Contract Performance Statement, which shall show, in detail, the estimated cost percentage of completion and value of completed performance for each of the construction categories given hereinafter. The format and content shall be prescribed by the Contract Manager and shall be subject to his approval. The submission of the required data shall not otherwise affect the contract terms.

# 15. FINAL INVOICE REQUIREMENTS:

In addition to the above requirements, the Contractor must provide the following items with his final invoice.

- a. Contractor's final release.
- b. Assignee's Release must be completed for Contractors with assigned payments. Assignee's release forms to be completed by the assigned financial institution may be picked up from the Contracts Office at GPSS.
- c. Prior to submitting final release, all punch list items must be completed. As-built drawings, Operation and Maintenance Manuals, Warranty documents, and any other close out documentation required elsewhere in this contract must be submitted.

#### 16. STORM PROTECTION:

When a warning of gale force winds is issued, take precautions to minimize danger to persons, and protect the work and nearby Government property. Precautions shall include, but are not limited to, closing openings; removing loose materials, tools and equipment from exposed locations; and removing or securing scaffolding and other temporary work. Close openings in the work when storms of lesser intensity pose a threat to the work or any nearby Government property.

Typhoon Condition of Readiness: unless directed otherwise, comply with:

- Condition ONE (Perform and complete actions required for "Conditions TWO, THREE, and FOUR." Sustained winds of 93 km/hr (50 knots) or greater expected within 12 hours): Secure the job-site, and leave Government premises.
- b. Condition TWO (Sustained winds of 93 km/hr (50 knots) or greater expected within 24 hours): Curtail or cease routine activities until securing operation is complete. Reinforce or remove formwork and scaffolding. Secure machinery, tools, equipment, materials, or remove from the job-site. Expend every effort to clear all missile hazards and loose equipment from general base areas.

- c. Condition THREE (Sustained winds of 93 km/hr (50 knots) or greater expected within 48 hours): Maintain "Condition FOUR" requirements and commence securing operations necessary for "Condition ONE" which cannot be completed within 18 hours. Cease all routine activities, which might interfere with securing operations. Commence securing and stow all gear and portable equipment. Make preparations for securing buildings. Review requirements pertaining to "Condition TWO" and continue action as necessary to attain "Condition THREE" readiness.
- d. Condition FOUR (Sustained winds of 93 km/hr (50 knots) or greater expected within 72 hours): Normal daily job-site cleanup and good housekeeping practices. Collect and store in piles or containers scrap lumber, waste material, and rubbish for removal and disposal at the close of each workday. Maintain the construction site including storage areas, free of accumulation of debris. Stack form lumber in neat piles less than 1 m (4 feet) high. Remove all debris, trash, or objects that could become missile hazards.

# 17. CONTRACTOR LIABILITIES FOR ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION:

Federal law requires Government installation to comply with environmental protection laws including but not limited to, the Clean Water Act (CWA), Clean Air Act (CAA), Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), and amendments to these acts including the Federal Facilities Compliance Act (FFCA). The Federal Environmental

Protection Agency (EPA) has granted inspection and enforcement authority to State and local Governments who may impose fines and penalties for violations of these laws. The station is subject to Federal, State, and local inspections to review compliance with environmental protection laws. A multi media inspection by and EPA agency may include questioning of Contractor personnel who are working with or have contact with hazardous materials and waste. Contractors shall complete and provide documentation for environmental training required by Federal, State, and local regulations. Upon receipt of a Notice of Violation (NOV), the Contractor will be held liable for damages due to his error or omission.

## 18. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION REQUIREMENTS:

Provide and maintain, during the life of the contract, environmental protection as defined. Plan for and provide environmental protective measures to control pollution that develops during normal construction practice. Plan for and provide environmental protective measures required to correct conditions that develop during the construction of permanent or temporary environmental features associated with the project. Comply with Federal, state, and local regulations pertaining to the environment, including but not limited to water, air, and noise pollution.

### 19. SAFETY:

Conform to the requirements of Federal, State and local laws, rules, and regulations on safety requirements.

### 20. PERMITS:

Permits are required for, but are not necessarily limited to, hot work and excavation. Allow 3 calendar days for processing of the application.

# 21. HISTORICAL AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL RESOURCES:

Carefully protect in place and report immediately to the Contract Manager historical and archaeological items or human skeletal remains discovered in the course of work. Stop work in the immediate area of the discovery until directed by the Contract Manager to resume work. The Government retains ownership and control over historical and archaeological resources.

### 22. CONTROLS AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTES:

Pick up solid wastes, and place in covered containers, which are regularly emptied. Do not prepare or cook food on the project site. Prevent contamination of the site or other areas when handling and disposing of wastes. At project completion, leave the areas clean. Dispose of solid waste generated at locations as directed.

Disposal of rubbish, debris, chemical waste, and metals at the Ordot landfill is prohibited. Dispose of rubbish, debris, chemical waste, and asbestos in accordance with the environmental law requirements.

# 23. GOVERNMENT FURNISHED MATERIALS: NONE



Submit data concerning the standard one (1) year warranty, including the warranty period (dates), and warranty contacts with names, addresses and telephone numbers. Equipment/Product Warranty List: Obtain and furnish to the Contracts Office a bound and indexed notebook containing written warranties for equipment/products that have extended warranties (warranty periods exceeding the standard one year warranty) furnished under the contract, and prepares a complete listing of such equipment/products. The warranty period shall begin on the same date as project acceptance and shall continue for the full/product warranty period.

# 25. CLEAN-UP:

The Contractor at no additional expense to the Guam Public School System shall dispose construction debris.

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
