OPA AUDITOR RECEIVES CFE CERTIFICATION

Hagåtña, Guam – The Guam Office of Public Accountability (OPA) is pleased to announce that Accountability Auditor I Thomas Eladio Battung has completed the fraud prevention and deterrence, financial transactions and fraud schemes, investigation, and law examinations administered by the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners (ACFE). On January 31st, 2022, The ACFE's Certification Committee approved his application earning Mr. Battung his professional designation of Certified Fraud Examiner (CFE).

Mr. Battung is an active member of the ACFE. The ACFE is the world's largest anti-fraud organization and premier provider of anti-fraud training and



education. The CFE professional designation is accepted worldwide as the standard of excellence in the anti-fraud profession. The ACFE requires each member to adhere to the ACFE Code of Ethics and complete a minimum of 20 credit hours of Continuing Professional Education directly related to the fraud and ethics every 12-months to maintain the CFE designation.
