**MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES** 

The time for hearings shall be set by the Hearing Officer. 2 G.A.R. 12108(b). In

analogous civil proceedings, motions for continuances are viewed with liberality. See Vol.9,

Moore's Federal Practice and Procedure, Chapter 7, §2352. Denial of a motion to continue a

hearing date may be proper when the party seeking such continuance has had adequate time to

prepare for the hearing; or when the party seeking the continuance has sought it at the last

minute prior to the hearing; or when the denial of the continuance would not prejudice the

moving party. Id.

The motion cutoff date is currently set as December 11, 2009 and a Pre-Hearing

conference following on December 3, 2009. Undersigned counsel was just retained on

December 10, 2009 leaving counsel with literally a few hours to prepare all documents

necessary for submission at the pre-hearing conference. Appellant submits that a minimal
