Now comes the Government of Guam, Department of Administration, General Services Agency ("GSA"), by and through its attorneys, the Office of the Attorney General, and moves the Public Auditor, with regard to the Decision issued herein on April 19, 2013 ("Decision"), for a reconsideration of a specific finding and ruling in the Decision, and for clarification of the nature of the amended Invitation For Bids required by the Decision.

1. GSA seeks the reconsideration of the findings and ruling which resulted in the determination that "GSA violated 2 G.A.R., Div. 4, Chap. 4, §4103(b)(1)(c) by including two (2) unnecessary inspection trips for two (2) GFD employees in the IFB specifications."



Quoting from Decision, page 12, line 13. GSA seeks to provide information concerning this

matter not previously available to the Public Auditor.

2. GSA seeks clarification that the nature of the amendments to be made to the

Invitation For Bids is consistent with the Decision, as one or more amendments to be made

may be construed as material in nature, although not a significant change in the nature of the

procurement so as to require a cancellation of Bid No. GSA-005-13 pursuant to 2 GAR, Div.

4, §3109(t)(2).
