REQUEST FOR ENTRY OF STAY

The Protestant PACIFIC DATA SYSTEMS, INC. ("PDS") requests that the Public Auditor immediately issue a stay in this matter. PDS filed a protest in GDOE IFB No. 014-2012 on Wednesday, September 26, 2012. Because this project is funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act ("ARRA"), and because the deadline for obligation of ARRA funds has been extended until September 30, 2013, this protest is governed by 5 G.C.A. § 5425.1.

That statute provides in part that "... The fact that a protest has been filed pursuant to this Section *shall not* stay the procurement process or award of any contract funded by ARRA monies, whether in whole or in part, *unless* so ordered by the Public Auditor ..." (emphasis in original). Since the filing of its protest on September 26, PDS has received the procurement record from GDOE, and has learned that GDOE issued Purchase Orders to Softchoice on September 21, 2012. A stay should thus be entered immediately so that Softchoice holds off on any action it might otherwise take to fulfill
