The Parties may file stipulated joint witness, exhibit, and issues lists, and admissions of fact in lieu of filing such documents separately. The term "Exhibit List" as used in this paragraph refers to exhibits that any party will present to a witness for testimonial purposes during the hearing in this matter. Filing Deadline for **Hearing Briefs:** May 13, 2015 at 5:00 P.M. The parties shall file and serve on the other parties, their Hearing Briefs summarizing their arguments concerning contested issues no later than this date and time. **Hearing Date:** May 18, 2015 at 9:00 A.M. The Hearing will proceed in the following order: (1) Opening Statements of the Parties; (2) Appellant's Case in Chief; (3) Interested Party's Case in Chief; (4) The Purchasing Agency's

Case in Chief; (5) Closing Arguments of the Parties.
