On September 10, 2007, Advance Management Inc. (AMI) filed an appeal with Office of the Public Auditor (OPA) relative to Guam Public School System (GPSS) IFB 006-2007 "Preventative maintenance and repair of split type air conditioning units for various public schools and support facilities."

On October 29, 2007, a pre-hearing conference was held before the OPA Hearings Officer on the matter.

On November 14, 2007, the attorney for GPSS, the purchasing agency, filed with the Office of the Public Auditor (OPA) a Stipulation of Dismissal based on the agreements reached by GPSS and AMI in the October 29, 2007 pre-hearing conference.

The appellant, AMI, signed and concurred with the stipulation of dismissal that stated:

- (1) GPSS will require all future contractors to sign certify bid proposals for compliance with Public Laws (P.L.) 26-111 and 28-165, the applicable prevailing wage and benefit laws; and
- (2) GPSS will coordinate a meeting with the Attorney General, the Department of Labor, the General Services Administration, AMI, and other government organizations and/ or vendors to discuss future procedures for award contracts to ensure that the awarded vendors will pay employees in accordance wit P.L. 26-111.

Further, OPA found that the AMI appeal did not conform to the requirements of filing an appeal. AMI filed no initial protest with GPSS and instead filed the appeal directly with the OPA. Jurisdiction of an appeal in this matter requires evidence of a formal protest and denial by the awarding entity in accordance with 5 G.C.A. §5425 (e).

As such, the Public Auditor does hereby order the above-captioned appeal DISMISSED without prejudice pursuant to 5 G.C.A. §5425 and the agreements reached in the stipulation for dismissal.

20	3) That GPSS agrees henceforth to have all contracts involving hourly wage							
21	be certified by the bidder as compliant with Public Law 26-111 and Public Law 28-165.							
22	4) That GPSS coordinates a government meeting to include the Attorney General,							
23	Department of Labor, General Services Administration and Advance Management, Inc. and							
24	other Government of Guam organizations and/or vendors to discuss procedures for award
