ORDER AFTER HEARING/ SCHEDULING ORDER

In the interest of administrative efficiency, and upon the consent of all parties present, a pre-hearing conference in the above-named appeal was held on October 30, 2013. Present for the Appellant, Cars Plus LLC ("Cars Plus"), was Leevin T. Camacho, Esq. Present for the General Services Agency (the "Government") was legal counsel Assistant Attorney General Fred Nishihira, Esq., who indicated that he was entering his appearance as counsel of record. Present for Interested Party, Triple J. Enterprises, was Matthew S. Kane, Esq. No objection was made to the Public Auditor's appointment of the undersigned as the Hearing Officer for this appeal.

As a result of the pre-hearing conference, the Public Auditor orders the following schedule:

- 1. No later than November 12, 2013, the parties may file with the Office of Public Accountability ("OPA"), and serve on opposing parties or counsel, oppositions or responses to any of the currently pending motions in this appeal. Optional replies to such oppositions/responses shall be filed and served no later than November 15, 2013.
- 2. The parties may, but are not required to, file any other pre-hearing motions they wish the Public Auditor to consider. Any such motions shall be also filed with the OPA and served on opposing parties or counsel no later than November 12, 2013. Oppositions/responses

to any such motions shall be filed and served no later than November 19, 2013. Optional replies to such oppositions/responses shall be filed and served no later than November 22, 2013.

- 3. The formal hearing on this appeal shall commence at 9:00 a.m., November 26, 2013, at the OPA hearing room, Room 907, DNA Building, Hagåtña, Guam.
- 4. The parties shall file with the OPA, and serve on opposing parties or counsel, the following materials by November 19, 2013:
 - a. <u>Formal Hearing Brief.</u> A formal hearing brief stating the party's respective position regarding the matters at issue in the appeal, with appropriate legal citations and citations to the record on appeal and Exhibits. The parties shall also discuss in their briefs what relief or remedies they are asking the Public Auditor to grant or award, with legal citations to applicable Guam statutes, rules, regulations, and case law.
 - b. <u>Witness Lists</u>. Each party shall submit a witness list of individuals it intends to call as witnesses at the formal hearing. The parties shall be responsible for ensuring the attendance of their own witnesses at the formal hearing.
 - c. <u>Exhibits</u>. Each party shall submit a binder of all exhibits it intends to rely on at the formal hearing.
 - d. <u>Joint Statement</u>. A joint statement by the parties of stipulated facts, if any.
- 5. No later than November 4, 2013, the Government shall serve a copy of this Scheduling Order on any other Interested Parties to these appeals, as the Government is the entity most likely to have the correct names and addresses for such Interested Parties.
