### Appendix A: Notice of Appeal Form PROCUREMENT APPEAL

#### PART IV- FORM AND FILING

This is a Procurement Appeal made under §12201 by Pacific Data Systems (PDS) of a Protest Decision by General Services Agency (GSA) regarding Request for Quote (RFQ) RFQ15000381. PDS believes a conflict exists with the RFQ service term language used by GSA with a previous Settlement Agreement made with PDS related to the same services that are currently under procurement appeal. The original protest was made by PDS on March 3, 2015 (see Exhibit 4). The PDS Protest was denied by GSA in a Decision letter faxed to PDS on March 10, 2015 (see Exhibit 5).

### **Background**

On or about February 6, 2015, GSA issued RFQ1500381 (see Exhibit 1) and requested a quote from PDS for the services described therein. On February 12, 2015 PDS requested clarification of several of the RFQ terms; one of which was the question if the services were subject to termination once the procurement appeal related to GSA-064-11 is resolved (reference the PDS - GSA Settlement Agreement related to these types of temporary services - see Exhibit 3). GSA responded to PDS' question on February 23, 2015 stating that "No" the services would not be terminated upon the resolution of GSA-064-11 (Exhibit 2 is the email string between PDS and GSA related to these questions). This "No" response by GSA was interpreted by PDS as a breach of the PDS - GSA Settlement Agreement (see Exhibit 3) and resulted in a Protest made by PDS on March 3, 2015.

### **PDS Appeal**

In denying the PDS Protest, the GSA Protest decision states that the PDS - GSA Settlement Agreement does not apply to this procurement since GSA is procuring Dark Fiber services and not any of the Telecommunications Services covered under the applicable GSA-064-11 procurement. GSA seems to have made this determination via its interpretation of the language of the RFQ, since the language mentions "Dark Fiber". Specifically the RFQ service specifications state as follows for each item of the RFQ:

### Item 1: Service for 1G Dark Fiber from OOT to Governor Complex

Item 2: Installation Dedicate Fiber Strand to Office of Technology Switch. Point to Point Fiber with No Equipment/Hardware in between. Vendor will provide 1G SFP Fiber Module for (1) 3COM 5500 and (1) Brocade Switch.

GSA ignores that the RFQ service specifications clearly state that the service will be a 1G service and that the vendor is responsible to provide the required 1G SFP Fiber Module to "lite" the Dark Fiber to a 1Gb capacity between the two points. What GSA has in fact specified is a 1G point to point telecommunications service between Office of Technology (OOT) and the Governor Complex. This is the same 1Gb service as specified in Part 11 of the GSA-064-11 procurement and therefore subject to the terms of the PDS - GSA Settlement Agreement.

### Appendix A: Notice of Appeal Form PROCUREMENT APPEAL

The GSA Protest decision also mistakenly mischaracterizes the PDS protest as a protest by PDS of this type of temporary RFQ procurement for these services. PDS does not object to GSA's use of qualified RFQ procurements to enable temporary telecommunications services, what PDS objects to is the issuance of these procurements by GSA with vague and ambiguous wording that seems to be designed to circumvent the existing PDS - GSA Settlement Agreement that applies to these types of procurements.

### RULING REQUESTED BY THE OPA IN THIS APPEAL:

- A. PDS seeks a *de novo* review of the GSA RFQ terms and conditions and a decision as to whether the terms of RFQ conflicts with the PDS GSA Settlement Agreement in place regarding these types of temporary telecom service procurements.
- B. PDS requests an order from the OPA that requires GSA to make required modifications to the procurement terms and conditions to make the procurement compliant with the PDS GSA Settlement Agreement or in the alternative to cancel the procurement.
- C. PDS requests that a hearing be held on this matter at the earliest opportunity.

1. The 1Gb WAN service being procured under this RFQ is the same as the GGWAN services previously procured under GSA-IFB-064-11 (Bid Form Part 11) that is currently under procurement appeal. Temporary procurement of these services is subject to the terms of the Settlement Agreement entered into by PDS, GSA, the AG, and OPA on May 18, 2012 (copy attached). We are in receipt of your protest dated March 3<sup>rd</sup>, in which you are protesting the Request for Quotation for a 1 Gb Wan service. The bases for your complaint is that you believe that this is the same request for service that is part of GSA bid number 064-11, which is currently under litigation. Because the entire bid is under an appeal, the services that are required is being procured through an emergency procurement. Furthermore, and more importantly, the issue of "dark fiber" is not in the bid document.

Therefore, based upon all of the facts, your protest is DENIED. You have the right to seek any administrative or judicial review authorized by law.
