



Eons Enterprises Corporation, appellant, (herein "Eons") was the lowest responsible and timely bidder for the contract to construct improvements at GCC in the form of Typhoon shutters.

The notice and published invitation for bid specified that it was open to all contractors. See page 10.

Eons is a licensed general contractor and is licensed in over 11 contractor specialties. See page 9.

The bidding sheet discloses that Eons was the lowest bidder. See page 7.

On April 26, 2010, notice was sent to Eons that a higher bidder Alliance Metal Specialties would be awarded the bid. See page 6.

On May 3, 2010, Eons requested that the Government re-evaluate the bid award and asserted that Eons was the lowest bidder. See page 5.

On May 24, 2010, Eons received notice that its request for re-evaluation and assertion of protest was denied. See page 3. The GCC notice was postmarked and mailed on May 21, 2010. See page 4. Accordingly, the alleged date of GCC notice of May 10, 2010 should be disregarded as either mistaken or in error.

On May 26, 2010, Eons filed its protest with the Office of Public Auditor.

SUMMARY OF GROUNDS:

Eons submits that it was without doubt the lowest bid and that its qualifications as a licensed general and specialty contractor are proven in the bid submission. The invitation for bids had not nor could not eliminate all general licensed contractors who are authorized to install, build and construct improvements to include typhoon shutters on buildings in Guam. Alternatively, the IFB is null, void and of no effect because the Department of Public Works has sole authority for the procurement of construction service contracts for new improvements to public property. See Z4 OPA Opinion filed May 5, 2010 (OPA-PA-09-012)
